

## NEW Schools programme 2020

This Autumn term we are pleased to offer a new schools programme, suitable for both KS1 and KS2.

**Your visit** to the British Schools Museum will include 2 sessions: A costumed **Victorian Gallery Lesson**, updated for covid-safety, and also our **new People and Places** programme.

Overview of the day's activities:

**10.00 Welcome children and adults, and safety talk**

**10.05 Introduction and explanation of the day's events**

**10.15 - 11.15 Victorian Gallery lesson, with role play**

**11.15 – 11.45 Break for toilet and snack**

**11.45 – 12.45 People & Places session** which includes

- Self-guided tour of Mr Fitch, the Headmaster's House
- Multisensory experience of the family Fitch's everyday life within the house, including videos, authentic objects to handle - and the smells of Victorian Hitchin!

**12.45 DRILL lesson** in the open air

**1.00 – 1.30 Lunch**

**1.30 Farewell**

Both sessions are £100 each for up to 30 children (i.e. £200 per visit).

A maximum number of 60 children can be accommodated.

Wearing Victorian costume for your visit makes the day even more memorable.

### **ALTERNATIVELY WE CAN VISIT YOU IN YOUR SCHOOL HALL**

The visiting British Schools Museum education team will be in costume, and in character throughout.

This is a morning outreach session of 2 hours, usually 10.00-12.00, and includes:

- **Introduction and virtual tour of the Headmaster's House**
- **Multisensory experience of life in Victorian times for people of all three social classes**
- **Mystery objects challenge**
- **Victorian lesson – an immersive, hands-on experience**
- **A Victorian keep fit lesson, known as Drill**

This is offered at the discounted price of £300. Maximum 60 children.
